Dan Clark presented amendments to the agenda: ECC impervious surface, Documents committee, table the tax sale properties discussion, table the entrance signs discussion until June, something to commemorate Steve Stern, fund raising opportunity idea, and possible shuttle to lake.

- h. Fred Suljic suggests looking into doing a Craft Beer Festival. Raises a lot of money. It generally raises between \$40,000-70,000. Need a year to plan.
- i. Cindy Wyatt addresses parking at the beach and suggests a shuttle from one parking lot to the beach. Ed suggests renting a van to test the shuttle idea on a busy weekend. Bruno DeVinck asks if we can clear the lots that we have and cover with wood chips for additional parking at the beach. Randy will research if this is possible.
- j. There was a long discussion regarding the golf cart rules and regulations and the safety of our property owners.

Amos Lemmerman 405MR-thanks Masthope Mountain Community Public Safety for helping a neighboring community to find a special needs child that was missing.

Phyllis Cobban 109FW-upset about the golf cart rules and regulation

Ralph Silvestri 175FW-questioning minutes from Feb or March asking about new technology on website. Do we have ATV trail maps and was inquiring about new horse trails. Randy responded our website is being kept up to date and continue to look into improving, not cost effective at this time. We do have maps of the ATV trails in the POC office. We could look into the possibility of new horse trails.

Leatrice Langer 458MR-there are dead trees at the mailboxes that should be removed and replaced with something that can survive in that environment. Questions Article 5, the inconsistency of the number of members allowed on the different committees.

Would like to know how these numbers were determined. Questions why Masthope wants to publish names of who is on the committee. Dan Clark will have Article 5 reviewed and responds that publishing the names of committee members is so property owners can approach the members with any questions or concerns. Peter Torchio suggests putting a cover over the mailboxes.

Rich Seidel 578MR- praises Public Safety and their efforts how they responded to a woman down.

John Grandy 6cm- asks if the committees are posted anywhere and wanted to know about the ATV committee. Dan responds ATV is not a regular standing committee. Masthope has 2 muskrats at Remembrance Pond and is concerned about them harming area. Peter Torchio responds that now is not the time to remove them. It could be harmful to the babies if they have. Peter spoke to a conservation officer when the muskrats were discovered. Questioned if golf cart lights need to be illuminated and do ATVs need seatbelts. Ed responded no ATVS do not need seatbelts. Foster responded golf cart lights need to be visible. Handbook should better clarify the use of golf cart lights. The court area could use stone. One cannot drive back to the courts. Randy responded that the gate is open to drive back to the courts.

Ralph Silvestri 175FW-can property owners be a part of the planning of the survey? Bruno says that anyone can attend the meeting and that the survey will be presented to the board for approval. Michele responds that anyone can attend the meeting and comment on the contents at the end of the meetings.

Managers Report May 29, 2015 Projects:

- 1 Falling Waters Culvert Bids will be received in June.
- 2. Paving Paving will be done in fall to allow for repair work on Constitution. Patch work will be done in early June.
- 3. Flood Damage Continued repairs to the drainage on Constitution should start next month.
- 4. Aqua Final restoration is being done.
- 5. Front entrance Temporary repairs have been done, committee will get together this month for possible ideas.
- 6. Beach house generator With equipment, labor, permits and construction costs this project will be completed for not more than \$13,000. Currently there is \$12,950 in the community generator capital line. 80KW Generator, 400 Amp automatic transfer switch.
- 7. ATV trails and training center Contractor is ready to go with approval of funding. Maintenance will install 3 culvert pipes.
- 8. Beach equipment Pedal Boats being delivered on Sunday. Boat launch dock should be delivered at the end of next week.

Public Safety

- 1. Holiday weekend went well, compliance with rules was good in general. All grace periods are off for registering atv's and watercraft.
- 2. Several citations have been issued to property where complaints were made last year. Hopefully it will set a tone for the summer and reduce complaints.
- 3. Golf Cart rules Warning were issued to many owners who did not have upgrades to carts.
- 4. Vehicles New motor being installed in Charger, should be back in service next week. Other vehicles good to go.

Maintenance

- 1. Pool The pools are up and running we were late in getting heaters on due to a leak, water was a little cool on Saturday. By Sunday water was up to temperature and no sign of leak.
- 2. Road Sweeping Continues to be done..
- 3. Landscape Grounds are being cleaned, mulched and prepared for additional plantings.
- 4. Beach All is good, new furniture has been ordered for deck area, loose chairs will be removed and permanent seating will be installed.
- 5. Roadside mowing will start in June.

Summit

- 1. Holiday weekend was a success, numbers up from last year.
- 2. Picnic went well with the exception of people feeding their friends who did not purchase tickets. Many of the comments from years past have been that pricing was too high, with a change of the menu we brought the price down. To get the price down we worked on a smaller margin and fewer menu items.

There were people still taking advantage of the unlimited items creating a net loss of \$166. We understand the picnics are community events and should not be seen as money makers, but we should never have a loss.

For our next picnic I anticipate that we will be using a wrist band or ticket system that will limit the number of items individuals can take.

- 2. Staff is all in place, job re-assignments are going well.
- 3. All is going well in the office.
- 4. Aqua meeting Next Tuesday is the UDC meeting, I have contacted Aqua to make certain that if the sewer plant is discussed that it be noted that it is their plant, not under the control of Masthope Mountain Community.
